DNA Identification

All Foveran master sires and our entire stud female breeding herd have now been DNA profiled (for confidence in the accuracy as to our breeding). All stock sold are DNA guaranteed.

Insurance

Insurance facilities are available at the office. Insurance is the responsibility of the purchaser and any stock left on Foveran is strictly at the purchaser's risk.

Vetted In-Calf Hinds

All adult hinds have been ultrasound pregnancy tested using a real time ultrasound scanner. Only confirmed pregnant hinds have been included in the sale. All testing was carried out by Dr Noel Beatson.

TB Status

Our herd status continues to be a C10 classification.

Conditions of Sale

The sale will be conducted by Rural Livestock Ltd with the conditions of sale as set down by the New Zealand Stock and Stations Agents Association, a copy of which is exhibited in the office on sale day.

Each lot becomes the purchaser's property and risk at the fall of the hammer.

Warranties and insurance are covered under separate headings.



Conditions of Sale cont./ Guarantee

Terms are strictly cash unless prior arrangements are made with the auctioneers. Accounts not paid within 14 days of sale shall bear interest, at current rate per annum from the date of sale.

The sale is conducted exclusive of GST.

A buyers commission of 5% is payable to nonparticipating companies and recognised independent agents introducing and accompanying purchasers to the sale providing prior arrangements [no later than 24hrs prior to sale] are made with Rural Livestock Ltd.

Intending purchasers are required to register with the auctioneers prior to the commencement of the sale.

No animals, embryos or semen sold by Foveran Deer Park or their germplasm or any subsequent progeny or germplasm, including the semen and germplasm of that progeny, may be supplied to a third party without the written permission of the respective stud.

This condition does not affect normal commercial deer farming or stud farming or the normal sales of semen or embryos as it only applies to entities with the primary function of commercial semen/germplasm activities.

It is a condition of sale of any animals, embryos, germplasm or semen sold by Foveran Deer Park that the purchaser agrees to include the following clause as a condition of any subsequent sale or gift of any animal, embryo, semen, germplasm or subsequent progeny or germplasm to a third party—"the purchaser acknowledges that it will not supply any animals, embryos, semen or germplasm to any commercial semen/germplasm marketing or sales entity, and will ensure that this clause is inserted as a condition of any sale or gift of any animals, embryos, semen or germplasm."



Foreword

Dear Clients and Friends,

Welcome to our 37th Annual Elite Hind & Weaner Sale which we are doing online this year for the first time. We have been thinking about doing our female sale this way for a while now and Covid-19 has hurried that process up for us.

We were lucky enough to complete our ET program prior to lockdown and so are able to offer some of our latest crop of embryos which are hot off the press.

We have included a number of new sires in our breeding program this year in both our ET program and natural matings. These include 5 new 2 year old sires that have been bred here at the stud. They have new genetic combinations to us from a breeding perspective and are mainly bred by ET. In addition we have included Hennessy and Cleveland which are two new sires to the industry this year along with Agnew (a full brother to Nixon) which we are very excited about.

Our continued focus is heavy beamed trophy genetics and this year we have concentrated on siresx with well placed bottom tynes to ensure they will produce good velvet on the way through. Although trophy hunting has stopped for the moment, we know it will return with enthusiasm once this Covid-19 is behind us. We also know that it takes time to produce a good trophy stag and so purchasing these genetics will ensure that we are ready with trophies when hunting resumes again.

As always the progeny is guaranteed. If you are not completely satisfied, we offer a replacement or a credit at a future sale whichever you prefer. So you can buy with confidence. All embryos are guaranteed live fawn on the ground.

We wish you all the best with your purchases and look forward to any feedback that you may have.

By continuing our intensive breeding programme in what we believe is the largest red deer stud in New Zealand, it is our intention to supply the NZ deer industry with the very best genetics for venison growth rates, velvet production, and also our fast growing high end trophy antler stags.

DBVs

Venison growth rates. We continue to develop this major trait within our deer herd, with encouraging results. Our German herd for example, with Master sires such as Amadeus, Bonn, Wredeson Major & Red Baron leading the way, and some of our weaners at weaning in February topping out at 90kg. Yearling spikers to 155kg and 2 year olds to 253kg.

Velvet

By identifying specific lines of deer for velvet production, we are constantly improving the performance per animal to improve not only the production levels per animal but also the components of velvet conformation. As a result our velvet herd continues to grow with fast improving results.

Trophy

The fastest growing component of our deer industry at present. Foveran's commitment is to supply for ourselves high end trophies, but also to supply elite trophy genetics to the deer farming community. The continued improvement of our trophy herd is rewarding us with some massive red deer trophy antler heads with long tined heavy wide "wow" type configurations. Our German herd strategically crossed with European and English genetics has given us the opportunity to do that.

Temperament We continually manage and evaluate the herd for this important trait.




Schedule of Master Sires



COMMENT: Cane has been bred here at Foveran. A son of the very heritable McCaw who has produced us so many top stags in previous sales. At 504 5/8 IOA, Cane was placed 4th in the National 2yr HA Competition. As a 3yr old he was placed 3rd in the 3yr section. As a 4 yr old he was placed 2nd in the 4yr section of the Rising Stars at 751 IOA. He was also placed 2nd in the National HA Competition. His mass of antler is impressive and he is growing another massive head this year.



Fitzroys antler growth was affected last year but we are pleased to report that it has returned to normal this year. A super long and wide head which he passes on to his progeny.





COMMENT: Sired by Fig Jam who has been scored at 826 IOA and with an antler structure typical of his breeding, Munro has an antler structure with the "wow" factor. His dam sire Discombe was a National 2yr HA Champ. He matured at 652 SCI with a 62 inch spread which looks to have been inherited by this young sire. Munro grew a stunning 705 IOA of antler this year and looked set to follow in the footsteps of his sire FigJam prior to his untimely death at the end of his breeding season this year.



His sire Rigby and grand sire Leon are among some of the highest scoring stags in the industry. The mix with dam sire Davidson is working well for us and we expect Mordecai to be a very high scoring stag at maturity.







We expect Macedon will be a super heavy weight antlered sire at maturity.
