Conditions of Sale

DNA Identification

All Foveran master sires and our entire stud female breeding herd have now been DNA profiled (for confidence in the accuracy as to our breeding). All stock sold are DNA guaranteed.

Insurance

Insurance is the responsibility of the purchaser and any stock left on Foveran is strictly at the purchaser's risk.

Vetted In-Calf Hinds

All adult hinds have been ultrasound pregnancy tested using a real time ultrasound scanner. Only confirmed pregnant hinds have been included in the sale. All testing was carried out by Dr Noel Beatson and our vet Amy Watts.

TB Status

Our herd status continues to be a C10 classification.

Conditions of Sale

The sale will be conducted by Rural Livestock Ltd with the conditions of sale as set down by the New Zealand Stock and Stations Agents Association.

Each lot becomes the purchaser's property and risk at the fall of the hammer.

Warranties and insurance are covered under separate headings.

Conditions of Sale cont./ Guarantee

Terms are strictly cash unless prior arrangements are made with the auctioneers. Accounts not paid within 14 days of sale shall bear interest, at current rate per annum from the date of sale.

The sale is conducted exclusive of GST.

A buyers commission of 5% is payable to non-participating companies and recognised independent agents introducing and accompanying purchasers to the sale providing prior arrangements [no later than 24hrs prior to sale] are made with Rural Livestock Ltd.

Intending purchasers are required to register with the auctioneers prior to the commencement of the sale.

No animals, embryos or semen sold by Foveran Deer Park or their germplasm or any subsequent progeny or germplasm, including the semen and germplasm of that progeny, may be supplied to a third party without the written permission of the respective stud.

This condition does not affect normal commercial deer farming or stud farming or the normal sales of semen or embryos as it only applies to entities with the primary function of commercial semen/germplasm activities.

It is a condition of sale of any animals, embryos, germplasm or semen sold by Foveran Deer Park that the purchaser agrees to include the following clause as a condition of any subsequent sale or gift of any animal, embryo, semen, germplasm or subsequent progeny or germplasm to a third party— "the purchaser acknowledges that it will not supply any animals, embryos, semen or germplasm to any commercial semen/germplasm marketing or sales entity, and will ensure that this clause is inserted as a condition of any sale or gift of any animals, embryos, semen or germplasm."

Dear Clients and Friends,

We have just experienced the driest summer for a long time. Some say for at least 40 years! At the time of writing we have only had just over 100mm of rain for 2024! We have been feeding out since mid January and so our weaners have not seen much green grass in their short lives! Despite this we have had a good breeding season as our hinds are in good condition although it has been a costly one with much of our feed having had to be bought in! We are hoping the drought will break soon!!

Our breeding program this year has featured some new sires to us and we have used a number of different sires in our AI program in an attempt to offer you a selection of new and exciting genetics! Jameson (owned by Donald Whyte) caught our eye when he was placed second in the National HA competition last year. We have also been using Alonso (1164 SCI), Rigby (1069 SCI) and Purdey (963SCI) genetics in our hinds for a while now and its interesting to note that they each hold a current World Record in the SCI record book!

Cane also features prominently in this sale which is no surprise given his heritability factor. He has now been taken as a trophy at 845 SCI. Although he didn't match the scores of the record holders, he still had a fantastic antler style that was highly desired by the hunting fraternity.

We consider the first three embryos as star lots – one being the same genetic combination as the \$28,300 weaner hind we sold last year!

Please note too that all of the embryos are guaranteed for a live fawn on the ground. All hinds have been vetted in calf by our vet Dr Amy Watts.

Thank you for taking the time to peruse our catalogue. Many thanks too to the purchasers and under bidders who participate in this sale. Your support is greatly appreciated! We wish you all the best with your purchases and we look forward to any feedback that you wish to share with us.

By continuing our intensive breeding programme in what we believe is the largest red deer stud in New Zealand, it is our intention to supply the NZ deer industry with the very best genetics for venison growth rates, velvet production, and also our fast growing high end trophy antler stags.

DBVs Venison growth rates. We continue to develop this major trait within our deer herd, with encouraging results. Our German herd for example, with Master sires such as Amadeus, Bonn, Wredeson Major & Red Baron leading the way, and some of our weaners at weaning in February topping out at 90kg. Yearling spikers to 155kg and 2 year olds to 253kg.

Velvet By identifying specific lines of deer for velvet production, we are constantly improving the performance per animal to improve not only the production levels per animal but also the components of velvet conformation. As a result our velvet herd continues to grow with fast improving results.

Trophy The fastest growing component of our deer industry at present. Foveran's commitment is to supply for ourselves high end trophies, but also to supply elite trophy genetics to the deer farming community. The continued improvement of our trophy herd is rewarding us with some massive red deer trophy antler heads with long tined heavy wide "wow" type configurations. Our German herd strategically crossed with European and English genetics has given us the opportunity to do that.

Temperament We continually manage and evaluate the herd for this important trait.
