

Dear Clients and Friends,

Welcome to our 42nd Annual Elite Sire Stag sale catalogue. We have a wide variety of genetics on offer in this sale. Some of which we are offering for the first time as adult stags.

At selection this year, most stags were only at velveting stage and so there is no ranking or comments re antler potential. Some stags on offer were grown out as 2 year olds and so we have included them knowing they have the potential to produce good heads.

As we have advertised we are selling Robert Hay as Lot 1. At the time of writing he looks to be developing another eye catching multi pointed head. We have used him since he was a spiker and so feel it is time to pass him on to someone else.

We have also included Jordan in the sale. He is a son of Cane that we have used selectively in our herd. We feel we have enough of these genetics in our herd now and so again are looking to pass him on to someone else. Both sires would make excellent breeding sires but also have good trophy potential.

In addition we have a good selection of 3 & 4 year old stags suitable for breeding and or trophy stags at maturity.

As with previous years we need to remind you that ALL ANTLER CUT OFF THESE SALE STAGS REMAIN THE PROPERTY OF FOVERAN. It is too difficult to keep antlers and deliver them to you later. The best way to keep your antlers is to have your stag delivered with his antlers on. Although this involves more cost, it is safer for your stag to take him home and remove the antlers when they are hard.

You are welcome to view the sales stags at any time prior to the sale by appointment. We are having an open day when the stags will be in the shed from 1-3pm on Friday 3rd January, when you are welcome to view also.

We look forward to catching up at the sale and wish you well with your purchases. Good luck with your bidding!

Conditions of Sale

Venue

Foveran Deer Park sales complex, Foveran Deer Park, Haka Valley, Kurow, North Otago, 8km from Kurow (will be signposted).

Deer Inspection

Deer may be inspected in the paddock at any time prior to the sale by arrangement. On DAY OF SALE deer may be inspected from 11.30am.

DNA Identification

All Foveran master sires and our entire stud female breeding herd have now been DNA profiled (for confidence in the accuracy as to our breeding).

Insurance

Insurance facilities are available at the office. Insurance is the responsibility of the purchaser and any stock left on Foveran is strictly at the purchaser's risk.

Conditions of Sale

The sale will be conducted by Rural Livestock Limited with the conditions of sale as set down by the New Zealand Stock and Stations Agents Association, a copy of which is exhibited in the office on sale day.

Each lot becomes the purchaser's property and risk at the fall of the hammer.

Warranties and insurance are covered under separate headings.

Terms are strictly cash unless prior arrangements are made with the auctioneers. Accounts not paid within 14 days of sale shall bear interest, at 24% per annum from the date of sale.

If payment is not received within 30 days from sale, reservation of title will revert to Foveran for security purposes until account is paid in full, including interest owing.

The sale is conducted exclusive of GST.

A buyer's commission of 4% is payable to non-participating companies and recognised independent agents introducing and accompanying purchasers to the sale providing prior arrangements (no later than 24hrs prior to sale) are made with Rural Livestock Ltd.

Intending purchasers are required to register with the auctioneers prior to the commencement of the sale.



Conditions of Sale cont./ Guarantee

No animals, embryos or semen sold by Foveran Deer Park or their germplasm or any subsequent progeny or germplasm, including the semen and germplasm of that progeny, may be supplied to a third party without the written permission of Foveran Deer Park.

This condition does not affect normal commercial deer farming or stud farming or the normal sales of semen or embryos as it only applies to entities with the primary function of commercial semen/germplasm activities.

It is a condition of sale of any animals, embryos, germplasm or semen sold by Foveran Deer Park that the purchaser agrees to include the following clause as a condition of any subsequent sale or gift of any animal, embryo, semen, germplasm or subsequent progeny or germplasm to a third party—"the purchaser acknowledges that it will not supply any animals, embryos, semen or germplasm to any commercial semen/germplasm marketing or sales entity, and will ensure that this clause is inserted as a condition of any sale or gift of any animals, embryos, semen or germplasm."

Our herd status continues to be a C10 classification.

All sale stags are guaranteed in terms of their genetic performance and temperament through DNA profiling. This does not include sickness or injury. Any stag that does not meet the standards mentioned above will be replaced or a full credit given to use at a subsequent Foveran Deer Park Sale.

Number of antler points – owing to the lateness of stags this year at the time of selection, we have estimated the number of points we expect to see at the time of sale. Please note these are estimates only and we give no guarantee as to the actual number of points on sale day.

By continuing our intensive breeding programme in what we believe is the largest red deer stud in New Zealand, it is our intention to supply the NZ deer industry with the very best genetics for venison growth rates, velvet production, and also our fast growing high end trophy antler stags.

DBVs

Venison growth rates. We continue to develop this major trait within our deer herd, with encouraging results. Our German herd for example, with Master sires such as Amadeus, Bonn, Wredeson Major & Red Baron leading the way, and some of our weaners at weaning in February topping out at 90kg. Yearling spikers to 155kg and 2 year olds to 253kg.

Velvet

By identifying specific lines of deer for velvet production, we are constantly improving the performance per animal to improve not only the production levels per animal but also the components of velvet conformation. As a result our velvet herd continues to grow with fast improving results.

Trophy

The fastest growing component of our deer industry at present. Foveran's commitment is to not only supply high end trophies for ourselves, but also to supply elite trophy genetics to the deer farming community. The continued improvement of our trophy herd is rewarding us with some massive red deer trophy antler heads with long-tined, heavy, wide, "wow" type configurations. Our German herd strategically crossed with European and English genetics has given us the opportunity to do that.

Temperament We continually manage and evaluate the herd for this important trait.





His dam sire Discombe was a National 2yr HA Champ. He matured at 652 SCI with a 62 inch spread which looks to have been inherited by this young sire. Munro grew a stunning 705 IOA of antler at 6 years and looked set to follow in the footsteps of his sire FigJam prior to his untimely death.

COMMENT: Robert Hay has been a great sire for us. We have used him since he was a spiker and so its now time to pass him to someone else. It's interesting to note that two full brothers including Henry Wider were also used as multi pointed spikers for mating and so we know this genetic mix has worked well. At the time of writing this he looks to have his best head yet.




COMMENT: Jordan has been used by us as a sire. As a 4 year old he was placed 2nd in the National Rising stars competition. He is a proven sire as you will see by Lot 8 and 13 in this sale. We have decided its time to pass him on to someone else as we have a lot of these genetics in our herd. He was scored at 666 4/8 at 4 years and we expect his head will be bigger than that this year.



COMMENT: We had this stag growing in our trophy mob and have decided to include him in this sale due to his trophy potential. When you look at the photo of Rigby when he was taken as a trophy at 1069 SCI, it doesn't take much to imagine this stag may very well follow in those footsteps. He's only 5 years old and looks to have those same high scoring tops and antler structure of his sire. This stag is well worth considering!






Comment: Sire Cane has produced many top sale stags for us and his heritability is now well documented in our sale catalogues. Dam sire Brusnis is also the sire of Brunswick with his hugely wide and long antler structure. Note that granddam 7348 is also a full sister to Titanic. A very heritable pedigree. This stag has well placed front tynes, looks to be wide and we are expecting multi tops at this early stage.

Lot 5: Tag 1038 Pure European 3yr son of Turbo




Comment: Sire Turbo has an impressive pedigree. He is a son of Nixon out of Leon's dam so high scoring antler genetics are a given. It is no coincidence that Malson appears as the dam sire in a number of sale stags on offer today. Note too Fig Jam (sire of Munro) is on the bottom line. This stag has very big front tynes and looks to have splitting treys. Just at velveting stage at selection but we are expecting multi pointed tops.




Comment: The only Dallas son on offer in this sale. An impressive pedigree with dam 120 also a full siter to Koruba and Malibu. This stag is very late growing his velvet but we wanted to include him in the sale for his genetic potential. We look forward with interest to see how his antlers develop!

Lot 7: Tag 22 Pure European 3yr son of Bombay Sapphire




Comment: The only Bombay Sapphire son on offer at this sale. Dam sire Kane was a full brother to Hector. Note grand dam 9448 is a full sister to Malon's dam. Lots to like in this pedigree. This stag is also a late starter with only two tynes visible at selection. Again we have included him for his breeding. He was a 31 point 2 year old so we are expecting a multi pointed head!




Comment: Sire is Jordan who is Lot 2 in this sale. Top performing trophy sires throughout this pedigree including dam sire Hunter at 817 SCI at just 6 years. This stag has strong front tynes. Brows are turned down. T'4 on the right and looks to be getting big tops at selection.

Lot 9: Tag 1037 Pure European 3yr son of Beauden




Comment: Sire Beauden shares his sire Fig Jam with Munro. Both sires had eye catching antler. Dam sire Brusnis is also the sire of Brunswick with his hugely long and wide antler structure. An extremely heritable trophy pedigree. This stag has started strongly with thick heavy front tynes. Trey's just developing at selection. A 33 point 2 year old so we are expecting a multi pointed head.




Comment: Sire Turbo has a strong offering in this sale proving his heritability. He has great credentials being a son of Nixon out of Leon's dam. Dam sire Munro is also the sire of Damascus. His antler structure is very heritable as you can see in many of his sons. This stag has started well with well placed front tynes. Not quite at velveting stage at selection so its too early to estimate points.

Lot 11: Tag 1141 Pure European 3yr son of Titanic




Comment: Sire Titanic has a hugely heavy head of antler and an impressive 70 points. He's looking great again this year. It's worth noting his dam is also Brunswick's dam. Dam sire Apex is the sire of Robert Hay. Grand dam 1080 is a well respected hind here at the stud being a daughter of Amadeus, and Brusnik her dam sire. This stag is just developing treys at selection and so its too early to estimate points.




Comment: Sire Mordecai was taken last year as a trophy scoring 875 SCI at just 6 years. Not surprising given his sire is Rigby and dam sire Davidson. Dam sire is Malson who has performed well in this catalogue as a dam sire. A top trophy pedigree with Fig Jam and Tarentino on the bottom line. This stag has started well with an attractive head. He has a double left bey, a thick beam and looks to be developing big tops.

Lot 13: Tag 1303 Pure European 3yr son of Jordan




Comment: Sire is Jordan who is Lot 2 in this sale. A son of high scoring Cane. His dam sire is Lord Haka who is the sire of Purdey. An interesting mix with Ardleigh McCaw as the dam sire. This stag has an attractive head at velveting stage with well placed front tynes and T4's. We are expecting multi pointed tops.



Comment: Sire Mordecai was taken as a trophy scoring 875 SCI at just 6 years. Not surprising given his breeding! Dam sire McCaw is the sire of Cane and with Huneric as the dam sire, dam 4171 is similarly bred to Cane. This stag has big well placed front tynes, possibly may have kickers or droppers but is bulbing to multi pointed tops.


Lot 15: Tag 1151 Pure European 3yr son of Cane



Comment: Sire Cane was 845 SCI when he was taken as a trophy. His heritability is now well documented in our sale catalogues. Dam sire Brusnis is also the sire of Brunswick with his hugely long and wide antler structure. Note grand dam 7348 is a full sister to Titanic and her dam is also Brunswick's dam. A full brother to Lot 4 and 19, this stag has started well at selection with well placed front tynes. Can't see tops but he was a 33 point 2 year old.


Lot 16: Tag 1322 Pure European 3yr son of Turbo

Comment: Sire Turbo has a strong offering in this sale. He has great trophy credentials being a son of Nixon out of Leon's dam. Dam sire Munro is also the dam sire of Damascus. His antler structure is very heritable. Many of his sons inherit the same eye catching antler style with tidy fronts. This stag is an embryo brother to Lot 10. He has well placed front tynes and we expect he will have multi pointed tops.


Lot 17: Tag 1069 Pure European 3yr son of Cane



Comment: Sire Canes heritability is now well documented in our sale catalogues. He had an impressive 845 SCI antler when he was taken as a trophy. A very attractive head. Dam sire Kallis is also the sire of Titanic with his 70 point antler. Note too Archibald is the sire of Alexander and former SCI #1 Charlie Mac on the bottom line. This stag is late developing his antlers at selection but he was a 38 point 2 year old so we expect multi points.


Lot 18: Tag 1260 Pure European 3yr son of Mordecai

Comment: Sire Mordecai was 875 SCI at just 6 years when he was taken as a trophy. Not surprising given his breeding with high scoring Rigby over Davidson! Dam sire Brusnis is also the sire of Brunswick with his hugely wide and long antler structure. This stag has started well. He looks to have a strong head with big tops and is wide.


Lot 19: Tag 1366 Pure European 3yr son of Cane



Comment: Sire Cane has another impressive offering in this years sale catalogue. His heritability is now well documented in our sale catalogues. Dam sire Brusnis is also the sire of Brunswick. Grand dam 7348 is a full sister to Titanic and her dam is also Brunswick's dam. This stag is a full ET brother to Lot 4 and 15. This stag has started well with good front tynes, nice shape, T4's developing possibly but too early to estimate points.


Lot 20: Tag 1234 Pure European 3yr son of Robert Hay

Comment: Sire Robert Hay has an eye catching antler style and features as lot 1 in this sale catalogue. Dam sire Fitzroy's sire line consistently leaves heavy beamed antler going back to Henry James who held the record for 2yr antler weight at that time. This stag has started well with his antler. He has well placed front tynes although not yet at velveting stage at selection.


Lot 21: Tag 1245 Pure European 3yr son of Minnesota



Comment: Sire Minnesota was an exceptional 3yr old son of Cane that unfortunately died before he reached his full potential. Dam sire Ardleigh McCaw is well known for his huge velvet weights. Note too Hudrock on the bottom line who brings Lincoln and Rio's dam to the pedigree. This stag has big front tynes, a nice shape and looks to have a good multi pointed antler which has earned him a place in the sale.


Lot 22: Tag 1181 Pure European 3yr son of Floyd




Comment: We acquired this Floyd semen in a trade and decided to use it over this Hudrock dam. She has excellent trophy credentials with Lincoln, Munro and Fig Jam in her pedigree. This stag has thick heavy fronts and beam at selection. This is new breeding for us and so not quite sure what to expect in the tops. We look forward to seeing the result.

Lot 23: Tag 1033 Pure European 3yr son of Mordecai




Comment: Sire Mordecai was 875 SCI when he was taken as a trophy at just 6 years. Hardly surprising given he is a son of high scoring Rigby over Davidson. Dam sire is Malson who crosses well with Mordecai as you can see by Lot 12. This stag has good front tynes with the exception of his left brow which wasn't noted last year. Just past velveting at selection, we are expecting multi pointed tops.



Comment: Sire Titanic's impressive again this year. He had 70 points at 6 years with an exceptionally heavy antler weight. He shares his dam 3291 with Brunswick. Dam sire Malson is the dam sire of a number of stags in this sale proving his heritability. This stag has strong multi pointed brows and basal snags. Not quite at velveting stage at selection but he looks to be wide.

Lot 25: Tag 1083 Pure European 3yr son of Titanic




Comment: This stag is a full ET brother to lot 10 and lot 16 and so we know this mix works well. A heritable trophy pedigree. This stag has good well placed front tynes just at velveting stage at selection.



Lot 26: Tag 250 Pure European 4yr son of Apex




Comment: Sire Apex is also the sire of Robert Hay. Dam sire Munro is the sire of Damascus. Both sires have reputations for leaving eye catching antlers in their sons. This stag, produced by ET, has well placed front tynes. His antler structure looks to be wide and he looks like he's going to develop multi pointed tops. Lots to like in this pedigree.



Comment: Sire Mordecai was taken as a trophy last year scoring 875 SCI at just 6 years. He had a massively long antler structure. Dam sire Apex is also the sire of Robert hay. Grand dam 9128 is a well respected daughter of Adonis. Note too high scoring sires in the pedigree include Leon, Davidson and Nixon. Terrific trophy genetics.


Lot 28: Tag 405 Pure European 4yr son of Cane



Comment: Cane's heritability is now well proven. He has produced us many many top sale deer. Dam sire Rigby is hugely multi scoring at 1069. He is also the sire of Mordecai. Both sires have been taken as trophies. Rigby's heritable antler structure can be seen in Lot 3. Exceptional trophy genetics in this pedigree. This stag was 25 x 29 points @ 3yrs. A strong head with big tops. It's an eye catching antler and heavy.


Lot 29: Tag 414 Pure European 4yr son of Metaphor



Note too dam 7348 is a full sister to Titanic and that her dam is also the dam of Brunswick with his hugely long and wide antler structure. This stag has started strongly in his antler development. He looks to be wide and we are expecting big tops.

Lot 30: Tag 408 Pure European 4yr son of Cane




Comment: Sire Cane needs no introduction. His heritability is now well documented in our sale catalogues. Dam sire Brusnis is also the sire of Brunswick with his hugely wide and long antler structure. A very heritable trophy pedigree. This stag has big front tynes, a split left trey. Kickers on both sides and big tops coming at selection.



Comment: Sire Munro was also the sire of Damascus. His antler structure is very heritable and that is evident in many top sons we have offered in this and past catalogues. Dam sire Orlando was placed 3rd in the 3 year National Rising Stars Comp with 611 IOA. This stag has strong well placed front tynes and we are expecting multi pointed tops.


Lot 32: Tag 322 Pure European 4yr son of Phoenix


Lot 33: Tag 209 Pure European 4yr son of Mt Cecil Lot 1
